Piano Due is the uptown branch of the highly regarded Scalini Fedeli restaurant. After a reception in the beautiful Palio Bar, we will be seated at one long table in the restaurant's private dining room. The menu includes a delicious Branzino alla Siciliana (seared wild striped bass in a Sicilian broth with tomato fennel confit and shrimp), a rich critically acclaimed Pappardella alla Cacciatora (pappardelle in an exotic sauce of wild game, finished with cream and barolo wine), Vitello alla Zingara (medallions of veal in a rich stew of wild mushrooms, pepperoncini and black olives served over faro) and a duo of the Chef's special desserts.
